The SAU 35 School Boards are seeking a superintendent to fill a current position as they work from their belief that it is essential for any community to have a well-educated and well-informed citizenry. To have such a community, educating children is of critical importance. In the process of educating, there must be an expectation of excellence coming from the top-down, as well as from the bottom-up. Our search for a superintendent focuses on bringing that expectation into our schools. A strong superintendent will benefit the entire community.

School Administrative Unit (SAU) 35 comprises seven towns in the foothills of the western White Mountains. The towns served by SAU 35 are Bethlehem, Easton, Franconia, Landaff, Lisbon, Lyman, and Sugar Hill. Our communities enjoy proximity to the White Mountains and Lakes Region, providing numerous outdoor adventure opportunities such as hiking in the beautiful White Mountains, fishing the streams, natural lakes and ponds, horseback riding and cross-country skiing the many miles of groomed trails, hunting in all the many acres offered by the White Mountain National Forest, and alpine skiing on premier slopes of the Northeast.

SAU 35 is governed by 5 elected school boards representing the towns of Bethlehem, Lafayette, Landaff, Lisbon, and Profile with an overarching Executive board. The schools in SAU 35 are Bethlehem Elementary School (K-6), Lafayette Regional School (K-6), Landaff Blue School (K-3), Lisbon Regional School (K-12), and Profile School (7-12). The SAU's total population is usually around 800 students.

- Identifies, prioritizes, and builds relationships with key stakeholders to foster goal attainment, building trust and consensus around critical decisions
- Works with and supports school boards to understand their roles and to achieve their goals
- Demonstrates financial acumen and fiscal responsibility
- Has a strong understanding of New Hampshire school educational laws, to include special education laws
- Supports and mentors members of the leadership team and the central office
