

Community Profile

Granby is a rural community of about 6,300 people located in the Pioneer Valley of Western Massachusetts, bordering Amherst, Belchertown, Ludlow and South Hadley. Granby residents have easy access to Springfield and the Five College area. The town was first settled in the 1720s and was home to small farms and industries. In the late 1800s, dairy farming had become the staple business in the community. The community is proud of retaining its friendly, small town flavor and much of its original layout, including the meeting house green. The Pioneer Valley is conveniently located to major transportation arteries; the Massachusetts Turnpike connects the region to Worcester (45 miles), Boston (85 miles) and Albany (99 miles). Interstate 91 provides direct access to Hartford, CT and Brattleboro, VT and other points north.
